Bowls of water, treats and biscuits for your pooch are freely on offer at many places and dogs are welcome to lounge with you in the outdoor areas or in the bar of most venues.

But some pubs have gone one step further and now your canine friend can actually join you for a meal, with dogspecific menus available.

The latest to join the growing num-



ber of pubs and restaurants with discerning doggies in mind is the Cupola Kitchen and Rooms in Stoney Middleton, which has launched The Cupawla – a menu just for dogs.

AWARD-WINNING singer and multiinstrumentalist Julia Knight returns to Buxton Fringe with her collection of comic and parody songs later this month.

Her songs highlight life's joys, absurdities and injustices in equal measure. Find out why she loves avocados but avoids extreme sports.

As well as highlighting issues such as the gig economy and the climate emergency, there are songs about journalist George Monbiot, gin and billionaires.

Julia said: "It's exciting to be back at Buxton Fringe festival this year to share my collection of songs.

"Despite addressing some serious topics, my material is light-hearted and creates a feel-good singalong atmosphere."

In addition to her self-penned songs, Julia sings some of Victoria Wood's classics, which featured in her first solo show. 'I Am Not Victoria Wood'.

Whilst in Buxton, Julia has volunteered to take part in the Buxton Fringe Community Links scheme which partners performers with local community groups.

She said: "The Community Links

programme is a fantastic way to bring the Fringe Festival to people who wouldn't otherwise experience it.

"Last year I visited a local care



home and a nearby hospice to play a selection of songs to extremely appreciative audiences."

Julia is a musician, singer, improviser and psychologist. Her first solo show, 'I Am Not Victoria Wood', had sell-out runs at Brighton and Edinburgh fringe festivals.

Her second solo show, 'Zeit-Heist: more than a feeling', premiered at Dundee Fringe and received three award nominations and one win at the Liverpool Fringe Festival in 2023.

She is a regular comedy performer of self-penned comic songs on the Dundee comedy circuit and beyond.
