



This Indenture, made the Eighteenth day of August in

the fourteenth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady VICTORIA, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty One BETWEEN James Hallam of Stoney Middleton in the county of Derby Farmer and John Hallam of the same place his son

of the one part, and William Worrall and Joseph Hallam of Sheffield in the County of York and George Worrall and Samuel Hallam of Dumfries in Scotland co-partners in trade as Needle Manufacturers of the other part; WITNESSETH, That the said John Hallam

doth hereby of his own free-will, and with the consent of his Father put and bound himself Apprentice to and with the said William Worrall for the term of until his attainment ^{of the age of twenty-one years} to be computed from

during all which term, the said Apprentice shall and will serve his said Masters faithfully, keep their secrets, observe their lawful commands, forbear to do them hurt, or injury, either in their persons or property, attend regularly and diligently to their affairs and interest, account honestly for all Money, Goods, and Effects committed to his Charge, and deliver up the same as and when required so to do, and in every respect conduct himself as an industrious and trust-worthy Apprentice. And the said William Worrall Joseph Hallam George Worrall and Samuel Hallam in consideration of such service as aforesaid, and of the covenant of the said James Hallam and of the said apprentice hereinafter contained doth hereby for themselves their Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, covenant, agree, and promise, with and to the said James Hallam and also with the said Apprentice, That they the said Masters their Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, shall and will teach and instruct the said Apprentice, or cause him to be taught, learned, and instructed in the occupation of Needle and Sewing which the said Masters now use

And also shall and will for and during the above term find and provide the said apprentice with sufficient and enough of meat lodging and washing and clothes except that the said James Hallam his Father agrees to find him in Shirts Stockings and Handkerchiefs
